Information on how to obtain a Resident ID Card is attached.

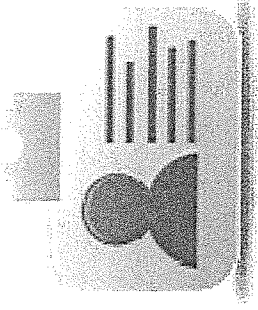
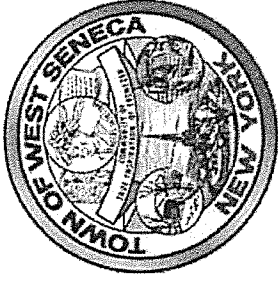

# WEST SENECA RESIDENT ID CARDS



All programs and activities sponsored by the West Seneca Recreation Department require a Town of West Seneca ID card. *It is recommended you obtain an ID card prior to scheduled registrations, or you will be responsible for the NON-RESIDENT rates listed per program or activity.*

The ID card must be current for registration and the duration of the program.

**ID's are taken on the following days and times at the Town Clerks Office (1250 Union Rd):**

Monday – Friday: 9:30AM – 11:30 AM and 2:30 PM – 4:30PM

2<sup>nd</sup> Saturday of each month 9:00 AM – 11:00 AM

FEE: \$10.00 Valid for 2 years from issue date.

Active Duty Military – Veterans - Under 5 Year of Age - Senior Citizens 60 & Over FREE!

## **REQUIREMENTS:**

1. **Proof of Age:** Birth certificate or Driver's license
2. **Proof of Residence:** Utility or Tax Bill and Photo ID – **Must present one of each!**
3. **Proof of Activity Duty Military/Veterans:** Military ID, DD-214 or Veterans ID Card
