RE: Monthly updates

Office Updates:

- We are working with the approved demolition contractor for 62 Columbia to coordinate demo. We are just awaiting information of the sewer abandonment, then we can proceed.
- The yearly 24hrs of in-service training, required to maintain NYS certification for all Code Officials, typically was held in person in early January each year. This has been transitioned to on-line learning. We have registered the staff to complete these in the upcoming months.
- We assisted the Emergency Management Office last week with the potential flood hazard. We met with the Fire Chiefs and Town of West Seneca Water Rescue personnel.
- We recently held the annual Plumbers Exam. This allows a plumber to take a test, coordinated through the Plumbers Board of Examiners, provide previous experience, and other supporting documents with a goal of holding a License in the Town to perform plumbing work.
- We have started the yearly reporting to NYS which details various aspects of the Town; permit quantities, new construction, renovations, etc. Every jurisdiction submits this information to NYS.
- There is an upcoming Planning Board meeting with 5 commercial projects scheduled for review.
- We have had virtual meetings with the Western New York Law Center in the past month. This is the agency that assists local municipalities in addressing vacant houses.
