To whom it may concern,

I would like to request a zoning variance for my property located at 23 Idlewood Drive, West Seneca NY. The requested variance is to allow the raising of poultry for the purpose of family pets as well as egg production. A maximum of six hens (no roosters) will be kept in a chicken coop with an attached run in the fenced area of my yard.

The coop (photos attached) will be located in the back portion of my yard. The dimensions of the coop are 55" wide, 96" long and 57" tall. Food and additional care items will be kept in plastic storage bins in my garage. The breeds of hens to be raised are cold hardy and will be eligible to stay in the coop during the winter months. Additional accommodations will be provided in the garage for any severe storms that may affect the hens, if necessary.
