The numbers are in for 2019! The West Seneca Youth & Recreation department provided recreational services for 12,982 people in 2019, this is up from 12,623 in 2018 and 6,364 in 2017.

The department was budgeted \$343,173.00 in 2019. As of the last budget report I received our year to date expenditure was \$251,393.29 with \$7,260.68 pending in encumbrances, with that the estimated total spending was \$258,653.97. A majority of the cost was staffing, however we did spend some funds on equipment, supplies, program trips, etc...

There is \$84,519.49 unspent in the departments 2019 budget. Furthermore, the department 2019 revenue total was \$362,069.30.
