Resolution for Changes in CARES Act Funding

WHEREAS, on January 14, 2021, New York State Commissioner Roberta Reardon signed an Order that temporarily cancels unemployment insurance charges to employers for the duration of the COVID-19 pandemic making unemployment costs unallowable for reimbursement under the CARES Act guidelines;

WHEREAS, the Town of West Seneca was originally reimbursed for unemployment insurance costs in the amount of \$89,337.24 as part of their CARES Act reimbursement, however, was able to reallocate \$38,206.30 of that funding to other CARES Act allowable costs that the Town incurred, at the direction of the Erie County Division of Budget and Management;

FURTHER, the Town also received \$100,000 of CARES Act funding to be used for the local share of funding related to FEMA, that was not utilized;

WHEREAS, it is understood that no other CARES Act allowable costs exist in which the Town could reallocate the funding to, therefore requiring the Town to remit unused Federal CARES Act funding to the County of Erie;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it

RESOVLED, that the Town Board does hereby authorize the attached 2020 budget amendment to account for the return of unused Federal CARES Act funding to the County of Erie.
