### **ISSUES OF THE PUBLIC**

A resident had the following questions on the warrant:

- ✓ Vendor 439 GDY, Inc. Who is this and what do they do Councilman Hanley replied GDY, Inc. performs pre-employment drug screening. Supervisor Dickson stated GDY, Inc. performs pre-employment investigations and drug testing; the cost is approximately \$6,000 \$7,000 annually.
- ✓ Vendor 427 -Tammy Frank Who is she and what does she do; if she is employed by a company why are the payments in her name Highway Superintendent Adams stated Ms. Frank performs on-site drug testing at the Highway facility. Councilman Hanley replied the bill is submitted in her name.

The resident stated the invoices are not submitted in the company name and could this be changed. Director of Finance Strauss stated it should not be a problem.

Town Attorney Hawthorne questioned if it is dependent on information on a W-9. Ms. Strauss replied all vendors are required to submit a W-9 with the business name and tax ID. Further, if the business is registered in Ms. Frank's name with a social security number indicated, the account would have been set up accordingly. Supervisor Dickson stated the cost is around \$8,000 - \$9,000 annually.

✓ Vendor 496 Candace J. Ignatowski — What is the \$655 payment for — Supervisor Dickson replied this is grass cutting on unmaintained properties that is added the tax bill.

The resident questioned why part-time Buildings and Grounds Laborers are not used to accomplish lawn cutting – Supervisor Dickson stated this is a flexible system and many West Seneca companies are used for this purpose; all costs are added to the tax bill.

The resident questioned why the check is written to one person, not a company – Councilman Hanley replied the individual could be the bookkeeper.

## A resident had the following comments/questions:

- ✓ Many road signs are obstructed by tree limbs Highway Superintendent Adams stated the town's tree crew is currently addressing issues around town.
- ✓ What is the status of sidewalk repairs Councilman Hanley replied the last time the sidewalk replacement project was bid only one company provided a quote at \$10 per square foot and noted the prior year's quote had been \$4 per square foot. Councilman Bauer stated he would like to have the Engineering Department resume the sidewalk repair process.
- ✓ Questioned if the sewer repairs being completed can identify problems in a property owner's lines— Supervisor Dickson stated according to Town Engineer Tanner the average cost to replace a sewer lateral is \$70,000 and the town is not allowed to view the lines on private properties.

## A resident had the following comments/questions:

- ✓ What is the status of repairs at the Burchfield Nature and Art Center, are efforts being made to mitigate further damage, is the building still insured Supervisor Dickson replied the grant request is still under consideration by the state. Highway Superintendent Adams stated measures have been taken until any grant money becomes available. Councilman Hanley confirmed it is covered by the town's insurance policy. Councilman Bauer stated a structural engineer reviewed the building recently and confirmed there has not been additional deterioration.
- ✓ Would the Buffalo Niagara Keeper's suggested action mitigate flooding at Union and Indian Church Supervisor Dickson stated the purpose of the project is to create flood benches where the water can occupy the land as opposed to backing up into Lexington Green and then School Street.
- ✓ Are parents aware that day camp could be cancelled at the last minute Recreation Supervisor Masset stated the parents sign a waiver at registration.

A resident from Angle Road commented on the frequency speeding and requested assistance. Chief Denz stated the police details will be increased and the speed sign will be placed on Angle Road.

A resident on Duerstein Street commented on the status of a repair made by National Fuel and the continued deterioration of the sidewalk. Councilman Hanley stated he will follow up with the resident.
