Customer understands and agrees that WNYIS will dispose of any trade-in or return leased equipment, associated with this purchase, as determined appropriate by WNYIS's Operations personnel. The customer understands that their trade-in or leased equipment will not be returned.

Terms and Conditions

- 1. Cancellation/back billing policy: either the party may cancel by providing written notification. Customer agrees to pay for all current billings and/or for all services and supplies provided under the agreement. Cancellations are effective per the following:
 - a. Monthly contract: the cancellation is effective at the end of the currently billed period.
 - b. Quarterly contract: the contract will be prorated by meter usage or at the prevailing "per call" parts, supplies and labor rates, whichever is higher.
 - c. Annual contracts: written cancellation is required 30 days prior to renewal. Customer also agrees to pay for any toner received in excess of normal usage associated with contracted copy volume.
- 2. Refunds: WNYIS will not refund any unused portion of a service agreement unless the agreement is being cancelled due to the customer purchasing a new machine from WNYIS with a new service agreement.
- 3. Supply/service toner: A minimal supply freight & handling fee will be added to your invoice. Periodically, WNYIS audits toner usage under supply/service contracts. Customers whose accounts show toner received in excess of normal usage associated with contracted copy volume agree to pay for the excess or return the toner. (same applies at cancellation.)
- 4. Renewal: annual agreements will automatically renew unless cancelled in writing 30 days prior to the annual renewal date, by either party.
- 5. Miscellaneous: this agreement shall be governed by and construed per the laws of the state in which dealer is located applicable to agreement wholly negotiated, executed and performed in such state, it constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and may not be modified except in a writing signed by duly authorized officers of dealer and the customer.
- 6. No warranty: other than the obligation set forth herein, dealer disclaims all warranties, express or implied, including any implied warranties of merchantability, fitness for use, or fitness for a particular purpose. Dealer shall not be responsible for direct, incidental or consequential damages, including but not limited to, damages arising out of the use or performance of the equipment or the loss of use of the equipment.
- 7. Breach or default: if the customer does not pay all charges for the agreement as provided hereunder promptly when due: (1) dealer may (a) refuse to service the equipment or (b) furnish service on a c.o.d. "per call" basis at published rates (2) the customer agrees to pay dealer's cost and expenses of collection including the maximum attorney's fee permitted by law, said fee not to exceed 25% of the amount due hereunder.
- 8. Price: prices are subject to change without notice. Maintenance agreements will increase by no more than 10% per year, at no more than one time per year. Customer agrees to pay the invoice for the agreement when received. Customer understands that alterations, attachments or specification changes may require an increase in charges and agrees to pay such charges promptly when due.
- 9. Service calls: service calls under this agreement will be made during normal business hours. Travel and labor time for service calls after normal hours, on weekends and on holidays, if and when available will be charged at overtime rates in effect at the time the service call is made.
- 10. General scope of coverage: this agreement covers both the labor and the material for adjustments, repairs, and replacements of parts necessary through normal use of the equipment as hereinafter provided. Damage to the equipment or its parts arising out of misuse, abuse, negligence, or causes beyond dealer's control are not covered. In addition, dealer may terminate this agreement under the following conditions: the equipment is modified, damaged, altered or serviced by personnel other than those employed by dealer; parts, accessories or components not authorized by dealer are fitted to the equipment; the customer negligently utilizes the equipment resulting in excessive service call activity.
- 11. Non-payment: in the event customer fails to pay for any contract services or parts rendered (in addition to the remedies of paragraph 5), customer authorizes dealer to enter customer's location of equipment during normal business hours and recover any parts installed from the date of last payment made.
